


- A national network of nearly 100 Clean Cities coalitions brings together stakeholders in the public and private sectors

Data Collected in Annual Survey

- Data characterizes:
 - Membership, funding, projects, and activities of the coalitions
- Data presents:
 - Sales of alternative fuels
 - Deployment of alternative fuel vehicles and hybrid electric vehicles
 - Idle-reduction initiatives
 - Fuel economy activities
 - Programs to reduce vehicle miles traveled
- NREL and DOE analyze the data and translate them into petroleum-use and greenhouse gas reduction impacts for individual coalitions and the program as a whole.






Historical GGE Reduced

Historical Gallons of Gasoline Equivalent Reduced




Historical Greenhouse Gas Emissions Reduced






2017 GGE Reduced by Fuel Type for Alternative Fuel Projects
