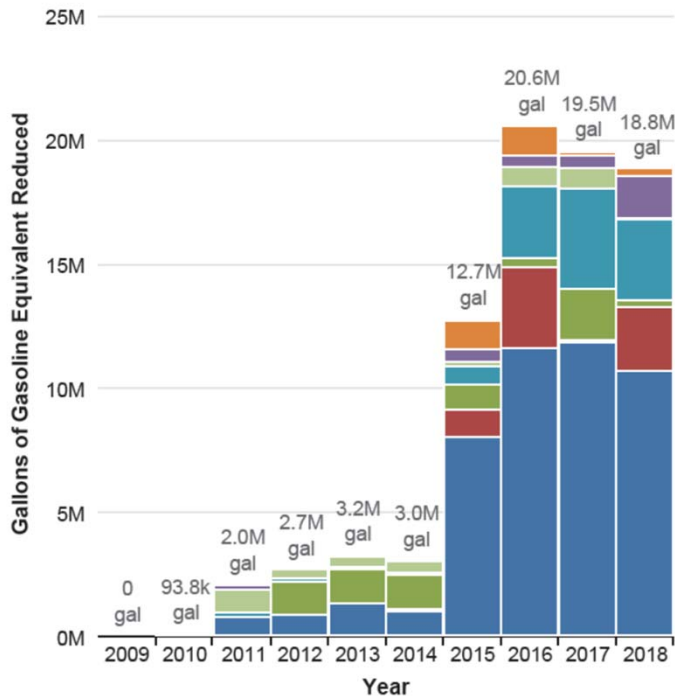


- 2018 report has been finalized and accepted by DOE
- 2017 survey respondents: 68
- 2018 survey respondents: 34
- DOE allows carry over of previous year's results, but with a reduced coalition contribution
- 128 organizations were included in 2018 survey
- 3 National Clean Cities Partners

Questions from Last Meeting

- What percentage of commercial vehicles are we capturing in the survey?
 - We don't know
 - Coalition has access to FleetSeek database. Indicates fleets headquartered in the region, not necessarily those domiciled here
- What is the pool of potential alt fuel vehicles that could be included, but are not?
 - We don't know
 - Most of our information comes from personal connections to stakeholders and manufacturers
 - H-GAC and others are working to gain access to registration data, but it is unknown when this will happen.
