Governmental Alternative Fuel Fleet (GAFF) Grant Program

The program will provide grants to eligible applications in purchasing or leasing new motor vehicles that operate primarily on CNG, LNG, LPG, hydrogen fuel cells, or electricity, including electricity to power fully electric motor vehicles and plug-in hybrid motor vehicles. The program will also assist in the installation of refueling infrastructure for grant funded vehicles. Eligible applicants include a state agency/political subdivision that operates a fleet of more than 15 motor vehicles (excluding motor vehicles that are owned and operated under contract) and a mass transit or school transportation provider or other public entity established or provide public or school transportation services.
